*Manufactu**READY** is an intensive, six-week training program that prepares unemployed individuals for success in the rewarding field of manufacturing.*

WHO ARE OUR STUDENTS

- Unemployed/Underemployed
- 18 years old or older
- High school diploma or GED equivalent
- Motivated for a better life through full-time employment within the manufacturing field

THE CURRICULUM IS RIGOROUS

Over the course of 6 weeks, students will engage in 240 hours of curriculum. Classes take place Monday – Friday from 8:30am until 4:30pm, where attendance is strictly followed, to simulate the work environment. The curriculum includes the following:

CAREER COUNSELING

All students are automatically enrolled in weekly career counseling sessions, where the student discusses their interests and potential barriers for full-time employment.

These appointments also serve as an introduction to work reviews, by discussing the students' progress in class. If there are areas of improvement, the students is given time to collaborate with the career counselor on how the student can improve.

THERE IS NO COST FOR ELIGIBLE PARTICIPANTS

Program tuition costs \$2,900. However, for eligible participants, the program is fully funded through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) and the Northeast Georgia Regional Commission (NEGRC).
