



21st CCLC/R.I.S.E. Application Process



- Parent/guardian **MUST** complete and return the 21st CCLC-RISE Registration Form in its entirety and return to the RISE Site Coordinator, Mrs. Sarah Behill.
- **WAIT** until you receive a **NOTICE OF ACCEPTANCE PACKET**. It will give your student's name, the date he/she may begin attending RISE, bus transportation information (if applicable), as well as additional enrollment forms that must be signed by both parent/guardian AND students.

A STUDENT MAY NOT STAY UNTIL THE ACCEPTANCE PACKET IS RETURNED WITH ALL REQUIRED SIGNATURES.

RISE IS ALWAYS TAKING APPLICATIONS, HOWEVER THERE IS A LIMITED NUMBER OF SPACES. STUDENTS MAY BE PLACED ON A WAITING LIST, IF THEY ARE NOT INITIALLY SELECTED AND CONTACTED WHEN OPENINGS OCCUR.

Submitting an application DOES NOT GUARANTEE ACCEPTANCE into the Program.

- **IMPORTANT BUS TRANSPORTATION INFORMATION:** Any student requiring bus transportation home **MUST** submit registration forms or any address changes to the RISE Site Coordinator by FRIDAY before the end of the school day. Bus route information/changes are submitted to the transportation department once a week, on Monday afternoons. **Changes in Bus Transportation home must be made at least 1 week in advance, in writing or by telephone call.** ***Bus Passes are not allowed in RISE.***

LMS RISE After-School Program Information

- RISE stands for Responsibility, Initiative, Success, and Excellence
- Hours of operation are from 2:30– 5:30 pm Monday through Thursday. **There is no RISE on Fridays.**
- RISE is closed on all WCSD holidays, breaks, etc.
- **Daily attendance is expected.** Any absences should be reported to Site Coordinator in writing or by phone. **Students *WILL BE DROPPED* from the program for poor attendance.**
- An afternoon snack will be provided, free of charge, to each child.
- FREE bus transportation is available.
- Please remember that the 21st CCLC – RISE After-School Program is not a childcare service. Students are required and expected to attend daily for full program hours and participate in all activities as instructed by the RISE staff.
