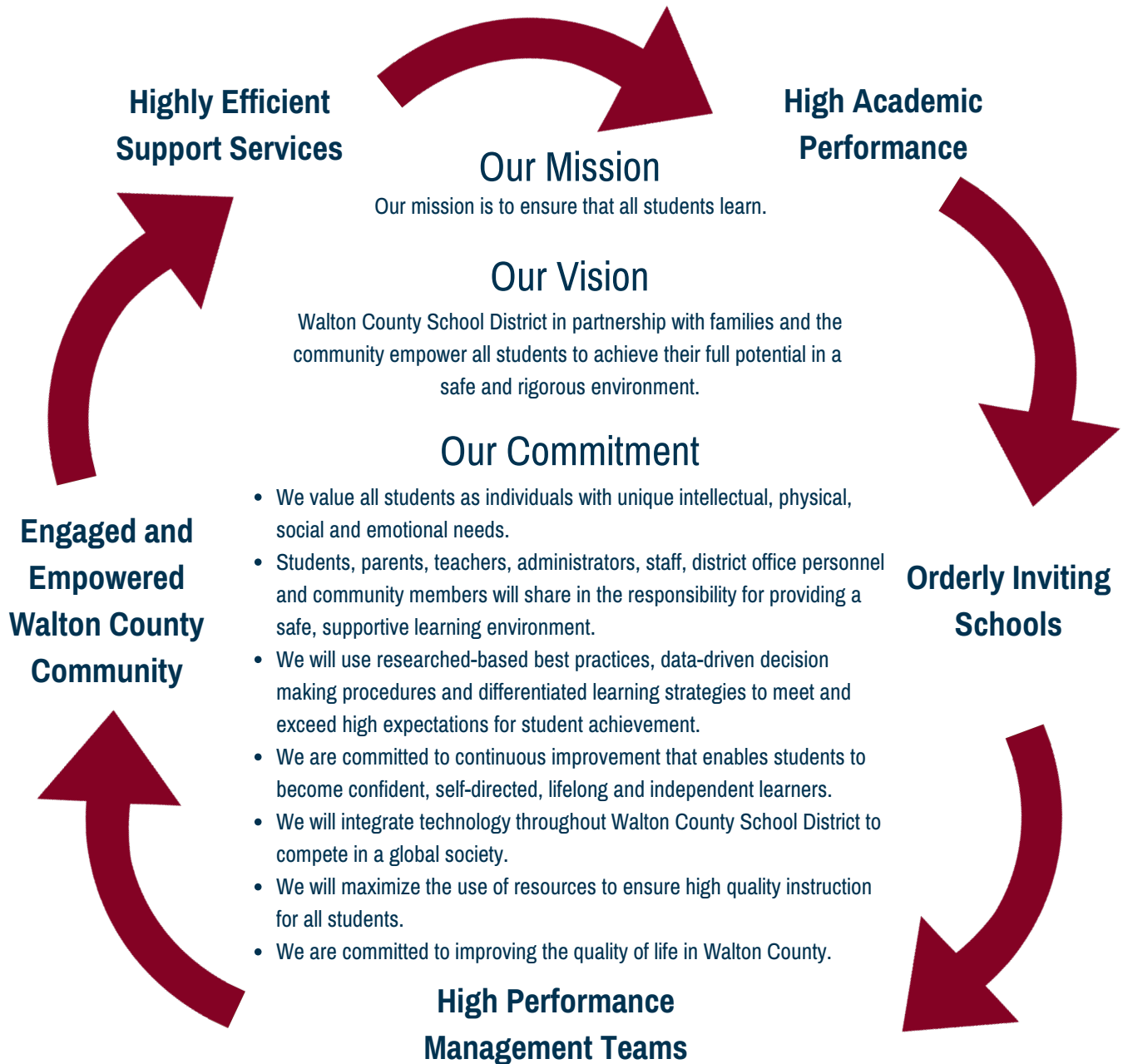

# High Academic Performance

## Goals

- All students will experience measurable academic growth at each grade level.

- All students will graduate high school and be college and career ready.
- All students will integrate the use of technology to maximize learning.

## Strategies

- Classrooms will be standard based and supported to maximize student learning.
- Summative and formative assessments will be used to guide rigorous instruction.
- Classroom instruction will be diversified and differentiated.
- Instructional time will be valued and monitored.

## Actions

- Continue to develop and refine Georgia Standards of Excellence and GPS instructional units.
- Provide quality professional learning through the support of county employed specialist, RESA and state specialist.
- Provide new teachers as well as returning teachers support through LFS/Best Practices Training.
- Provide professional learning on the integration of technology resources to increase academic achievement in all subjects by implementing technology plan.
- Expand non-traditional learning opportunities such as: 5th Block, before/after school programs, intercession, dual enrollment, Flexible Learning Plan and summer school.
- Provide on-going training using SLDs as well as other student growth indicators.
- Provide opportunities for teachers to plan and construct lessons, units and assessments at both the school and district levels.

- Continue and strengthen communication and community partnerships and parental involvement to enhance learning opportunities for all students.

## **Strategies**

- To improve the auditing, monitoring and financial reporting process.
- To provide efficient facilities and maintenance service.
- To increase efficient technology support.
- To provide efficient, quality and cost efficient food services.

## **Actions**

- Continue MUNIS upgrades and review financial procedures and internal controls annually.
- Maintain fiscal audit with no more than three findings or less.
- To acquire Energy Star Ratings for all facilities.
- To maintain ongoing training for facility and ground maintenance staff.
- To implement strategies to maintain high quality, low cost meal services.
- Provide ongoing training for Nutrition staff.
